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## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 101 SCHOOL SYSTEM EVALUATION**

### **Background**

School system evaluation is part of a continuous process in the annual development cycle for education plans and results reports. The system will be continuously evaluated with respect to the provincial goals and strategies determined by Alberta Education and the local goals and strategies determined by the Division to ensure that students have the opportunity to meet the standards of education set by the Minister.

### **Procedures**

1. The Superintendent has the primary responsibility for the continuous evaluation of the system.
2. The system evaluation is part of the Division planning, budgeting, assessment, reporting and improvement cycle.
