



ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 111

COUNCIL OF SCHOOL COUNCILS

Background

The Division supports and encourages the formation of a Council of School Councils as a means to enhance the communications between the Board and School Councils and among School Councils.

Procedures

1. The prime functions of the Council of School Councils will be to:
 - 1.1 Provide an opportunity for School Councils to share matters of philosophy, policies and procedures relative to the educational system;
 - 1.2 Enhance communication amongst the School Councils, the Board and the community;
 - 1.3 Provide an opportunity for the School Councils to collectively provide advice, and consider and make recommendations to the Board and the Government of Alberta on educational matters; and
 - 1.4 Share information on current educational developments affecting the system.
2. Each School Council will decide if they wish to have representation on the Council of School Councils. The representative designated shall be a member of the School Council.
3. The Council of School Councils will be composed only of those representatives identified by participating School Councils.
4. Trustee(s) and the Superintendent or designate may attend meetings of the Council of School Councils.
5. The Council of School Councils has the opportunity to be a delegation at a Board meeting in accordance with Board Policy 7.
