SCHOOL EVALUATION

Background

School evaluation is part of a continuous process in the annual development cycle for education plans and results reports. Schools will be continuously evaluated with respect to the achievement of provincial goals and strategies determined by Alberta Education, the local goals and strategies determined by the Division, and the school goals and strategies to ensure that students have the opportunity to meet the standards of education set by the Minister.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent has the primary responsibility for the continuous evaluation of schools in the Grande Yellowhead Public School Division.

2. School evaluation is part of the Division planning, budgeting, assessment, reporting and improvement cycle.
