



ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 305

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Background

The Division believes that it can provide each student with the opportunity to meet the standards of education set by the Minister by effectively utilizing the human and physical resources of the Division. In order to achieve this goal the Division establishes attendance areas for each school in the Division

Procedures

1. Attendance areas are established in compliance with Sections 13(2) and 45 of the School Act.

- 1.1 **Evansview School:**

- All Kindergarten to grade 6 students residing within and along the following boundaries:

- 1.1.1 Evansburg north to the Regional Division boundary.

- 1.1.2 Evansburg south to the Regional Division boundary.

- 1.1.3 Evansburg west to the Wildwood School Boundary as shown in Appendix E

- 1.1.4 Evansburg east to the Pembina River.

- 1.2 **Grand Trunk High School:**

- All grade 7 to grade 9 students residing in the Evansview School attendance area. All grade 10 to grade 12 students residing in the following areas:

- 1.2.1 Evansview School attendance area

- 1.2.2 Entwistle School attendance area

- 1.2.3 Wildwood School attendance area

- 1.2.4 In the shared area at the eastern side of the Niton attendance area the grade 10 to grade 12 students have the choice either to attend Parkland Composite High School or to attend Grand Trunk High School.

1.3 **Wildwood School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 9 students residing within the area shown in Appendix 305E.

1.4 **Niton Central:**

All Kindergarten to grade 9 students residing within and along the following boundaries:

1.4.1 Niton north to the Regional Division boundary.

1.4.2 Niton south to the Regional Division boundary.

1.4.3 Niton east to the Wildwood School Boundary as shown in Appendix 305E.

1.4.4 Niton west to the Fulham Elementary School boundary as shown in Appendix 305D.

1.4.5 Niton west to the A.H. Dakin School Boundary as shown in Appendix 305C.

1.5 **Fulham School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 6 students residing within the area shown in Appendix 305D.

1.6 **Evergreen School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 5 students residing within and along the following boundaries (excluding French Immersion):

1.6.1. In the town of Edson

1.6.1.1 All Kindergarten to grade 5 students residing within the area shown in Appendix 305A.

1.6.2 Rural Edson

All Kindergarten to grade 5 students residing within the areas;

1.6.2.1 Edson north to the Regional Division boundary.

1.6.2.2 Edson south to the Regional Division boundary.

1.6.2.3 Edson east to the A.H. Dakin Elementary Boundary as shown in Appendix 305B and Appendix 305C

1.6.2.4 Edson west to Range Road 220

1.7 **Westhaven:**

All Kindergarten to grade 5 English students residing within the areas:

1.7.1 In the town of Edson as shown in Appendix 305A;

1.7.2 Edson north to the Regional Division boundary as shown in Appendix 305B

All Kindergarten to grade 5 French Immersion students in the Edson area.

1.8 **Pine Grove School:**

All grade 6 to grade 8 English students in the Edson area. All grade 6 to grade 8 French Immersion students in the Edson area. All grade 7 and grade 8 students residing in the Fulham attendance area.

1.9 **A.H. Dakin School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 5 students residing within the areas:

1.9.1 in the town of Edson as shown in Appendix 305A;

1.9.2 Edson north and east as shown in Appendix 305B;

1.9.3 Edson south and east as shown in Appendix 305C.

1.10 **Parkland Composite High School:**

All grade 9 to grade 12 students residing in the following attendance areas:

1.10.1 Fulham School attendance area.

1.10.2 Pine Grove School attendance area.

All grade 10 to grade 12 students residing in the Niton attendance area with the exception of the shared area at the eastern side of the Niton attendance area. In the shared area the grade 10 to grade 12 students have the choice to attend Parkland Composite High School or to attend Grand Trunk High School.

1.11 **Crescent Valley School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 7 students residing within and along the following boundaries (excluding French Immersion students):

1.11.1 The Hinton Valley area north of the railroad tracks.

1.11.2 The Hill area west of the Highway Yards and north of Highway 16.

1.11.3 River Road.

1.11.4 East Hardisty

1.11.5 Brule.

1.11.6 Entrance.

1.11.7 Cadomin.

1.11.8 Highway 16 west to the Jasper National Park gates.

1.11.9 Highway 16 east to Obed.

1.12 Mountain View School:

All Hinton area French Immersion students Kindergarten to grade 7. All Kindergarten to grade 7 students residing within and along the following boundaries:

1.12.1 The Hill area north of the Trans-Mountain pipeline and including students residing in the Cecilia Park area.

1.12.2 The Hill area south of the Trans-Mountain pipeline and east of (and including) McPherson Drive.

1.12.3 Eaton Subdivision.

1.12.4 Thompson Lake Subdivision.

1.12.5 Sunset Trailer Court.

1.13 Harry Collinge High School:

All grade 8 to grade 12 students, English and French Immersion, residing within the following areas:

1.13.1 Crescent Valley school attendance area.

1.13.2 Mountain View school attendance area.

1.14 Jasper Elementary School:

All Kindergarten to grade 6 students residing in and around the Town of Jasper.

1.15 Jasper Junior Senior High School:

All grade 7 to grade 12 students residing in and around the Town of Jasper.

1.16 **Sheldon Coates School:**

All Kindergarten to grade 3 students residing in and around the Town of Grande Cache.

1.17 **Summitview School:**

All grades 4 to grade 8 students and early intervention students residing in and around the Town of Grande Cache.

1.18 **Grande Cache Community High School:**

1.18.1 All grades 9 to grade 12 students residing in and around the Town of Grande Cache.

1.18.2 All students registered in the Christian Alternative Program.

2. Out-of-boundary attendance is permitted within defined constraints.

2.1 Schools shall ensure that all students residing within the attendance area defined for the school are accommodated before accepting students from outside the school attendance area.
